

	<p>Our Learning...</p> <p>The children have enjoyed finding the many minibeasts in our garden. Therefore, we have been exploring different life cycles. We are eagerly waiting on the arrival of 5 caterpillars and are excited to watch them change over time.</p> <p>We have also been busy planting different vegetables in the raised beds.</p>
	<p>Wonderful Wednesday's</p> <p>The morning children participated in their final Wonderful Wednesday. We explored 3 different activities focused on 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' which included threading, tasting fruits and painting.</p>
	<p>Sports Day</p> <p>The morning children's sports day event will take place on Thursday 13th June at 10:30am (weather permitting). Parents/carers and extended family members are welcome to come along and support their child.</p>

	<p>Beach trip</p> <p>Both our morning and afternoon groups are invited to join the nursery team at Yellowcraigs Beach, Dirlerton on the 27th June at 9.30am until 12.30pm. The nursery will provide a picnic lunch for their children but parents are asked to bring lunch for themselves and any siblings they may bring along. Aberlady staff will be doing games and a treasure hunt etc. but parents will be responsible for the safety and behaviour of the children during the trip.</p> <p>Pupils will need to be transported by parents – if you can't take your child, please feel free to buddy up with another parent but they must agree to be responsible for your child on the day. If you are not able to make this arrangement, please let our nursery team know.</p> <p>Please note there is a £2 parking charge at Yellowcraigs beach carpark.</p> <p>We hope the weather is good to us, please feel free to bring buckets, spaces, towels etc.</p> <p>There will be no afternoon nursery session on Thursday 27th because of this trip.</p>
	<p>Nursery Entrance</p> <p>Please can we remind parent/carers that it should only be the adult ringing the entrance door buzzer? For the safety of our children we ask that the nursery door should not be held open by adults or children. If your child is to run on ahead they must wait outside and enter the nursery with their responsible adult.</p> <p>Thank you!</p>
	<p>Books</p> <p>The nursery acknowledges the importance of books for early literacy and therefore has been reviewing our library. Thank you to Amanda (Max's mum) for helping us to sort through the mountain of books. Once we have finished reviewing the books we will have a better idea of what books we would like to purchase.</p>
