Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born in Salzburg in 1756 and lived much of his life in Vienna, Austria. He was a prodigy on piano and violin and composed more than 600 pieces of classical music.

Mozart's most famous pieces include *Eine Kleine Nachtmusik*, an opera called *Die Fledermaus (The Bat)* and *Piano Sonata in C major*.

Genre: Classical, music for orchestra and piano.
