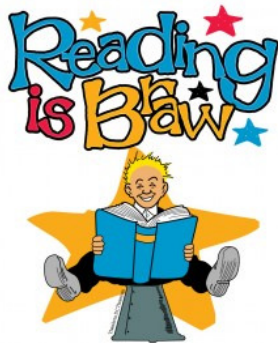




Campie Community Newsletter
