We have supported the school with their 100yr celebrations, meet the teachers events and parent consultations.</p> <p>We need to work on increasing and encouraging the flow of views from parents and carers in the Campie community to the parent council meetings.</p> <p>The main area of communication is via the face book page thanks to the comms team. This page has had reached as high as 4,211 and page views as high as 680!</p> <p>Going forward we hope to do the following - Create a regular mail chimp newsletter, consider new subgroups, recruit new pc members, recruit a new chair, update campie community website monthly and continue our excellent work on the cost of the School day.</p>	
3	Head Teachers Report	<p>Looking back at 2018/2019 - Campie celebrated their 100 yr birthday which was a great success and involved the children and the wider community.</p> <p>One focus was attainment with regular meetings where they look at each child in each class and check who is on track and if there are any children that need support. High percentage of</p>	

		<p>children meeting the attainment benchmarks in the school for reading and maths but slightly low for writing.</p> <p>Curriculum - there is now a rationale that has been worked on as a team to create a school specific Colleague Activity Tracking Plan (CAT plan)</p> <p>Self evaluation is a big part of the School Improvement plan and this is something that the team do at the end of each CAT meeting.</p> <p>East Lothian Council Review Team came to the school earlier in the year to meet with parents, teachers and children. Clear vision, Strong Leadership team, Strong relationships with the nursery. Improvements required - Campie need to build capacity for improvement, improve consistency in teaching, learning and communication. Monitoring and tracking progress within the nursery.</p> <p>PEF funding - some was spent on 1.5 teachers and an additional needs auxilliary staff.</p>
