In Literacy and English

we will be learning to:

Writing

Personal Writing - to draw pictures about themselves and their families and describe what they have drawn. Teachers will model adding details such as facial features to drawings.

Reading and Phonics

The pupils will be introduced to the initial sounds, they will learn to read, write and say these.

Talking and Listening

- Listen carefully whilst sitting on the carpet.
- Practise their listening skills by listening to each other and instructions from their teacher.
- Talk in partners to share their ideas with others.
- Deliver a solo talk with all about me photo

Handwriting

- Develop a correct pencil grip.
- Write our first name.
- Handwrite numerals 0-10.
- Handwrite the sounds we have been learning in class.

In Health and Wellbeing

we will be learning to:

- Identify our feelings through the Zones of regulation
- Create a class charter linked to the UNICEF Rights of the Child
- Identify and discuss our 4 school values ~ Curious, Positive, Respectful, Successful

In Numeracy and Mathematics

we will be learning to:

Numeracy:

- Read, order, sequence and identify numerals to 15.
- Understand the concept of 0.
- Say before and after numbers within 10.
- Add and subtract small doubles.

Maths – Pattern:

- Identify and describe simple patterns.
- Talk about patterns I can see or have made.
- Make a sound or movement pattern.
- Copy patterns using 2 set criteria.
- Make my own repeating pattern.
