MOBILE PHONE/SMART DEVICES

CODE OF CONDUCT

In recognition of the growing range, sophistication and number of devices owned by students the following code of conduct now applies. It aims to encourage **wise and responsible** use.

- Students bring these devices to school at their own risk.
- Phones must always be **kept in school bags**. They should not be stored in pockets or carried around in students hands
- Phones should not be used in class unless under direction from the class teacher. They should be left in bags.
- Phones should not be connected to any school IT equipment.
- If connected to Connected Learning Network (CLN) video streaming (e.g. YouTube) should not be used as this slows the connection across the whole school. **Respect your network and our community** - Don't be a bandwidth hog!
- Phones or other devices (including listening to music) should not be used whilst walking along corridors and up/down stairs.
- At break and lunch student can use their mobile phones if seated in one of our social areas.
- Any use of phones in school should be **WISE** and **RESPECTFUL**.
- Do not send unpleasant or inappropriate content.
- Do not take images or videos of others without their consent.
- No photos or videos taken in school, even with consent, should be posted to Social Media
- Failure to adhere to this code of conduct may result in phones being retained in the school office. Parents/ carers or others may become involved if the misuse is more serious and could result in students being prevented from bringing mobile devices into school.
