# Nat 5 Requirements for 2020/21

# Higher Requirements for 2020/21

**1 Assignment worth 70% of the mark (completed by the 4th of March)**

Completed projects contain a finished media file as well as an accompanying logbook which details all the work they have done.

**1 end of year listening paper worth 30% of the mark (on 4th May)**
