P7 Transition Visit June 2022

We are really looking forward to welcoming the Primary 7's to DGS for the 3 day transition visit. Please find below details of the programme.

Friday 10th June	Pupils will meet their Guidance Teacher and get to know which class they are in.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils should register at their Primary School as normal and will then be escorted to DGS for 9.00am. • Pupils can bring money to place on their smart card for the 2 day visit (preferably coins) however you should be able to add money to this via the online School Pay (£10 is a suggested amount). Pupils may prefer to bring a packed lunch on the Monday and Tuesday. • Pupils should bring a snack for break time on the Friday as they won't be able to access the bistro or hub. • Pupils will get to see their timetable and it will be reissued on Monday morning. • Pupils will be dismissed from DGS at 12 pm to make their own way home. Primary schools will provide information on travel arrangements as appropriate.
Mon 13th and Tues 14th June	Two Day visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils should make their way to the Assembly Hall in DGS for 8.25am and will be dismissed from School at 3.25pm. They will follow their timetable for the 2 days. • All pupils will remain on the school grounds for break and lunch. They will be dismissed 15 minutes earlier for break and will have their lunch during period 5 to allow access to the Bistro before the rest of the school. • Outlying pupils should use school transport to DGS. Primary schools will provide information on travel arrangements as appropriate. • Pupils must bring their Smart Card to DGS for the two day visit. • Pupils can add extra money if necessary during the 2 days.

Some additional information

- Pupils will be told which class and House they are in on Friday 10th June. Ties, which reflect each House, will be available to buy online via School Pay prior to the transition days and will be issued to students during these days. These can also be bought in school during the transition days at a cost of £6.50, which should be in a sealed, named envelope. You can also pay by cheque made payable to East Lothian Council.
- S6 prefects will be assigned to each class during the visit to help pupils navigate their way around the school.
- Parents should contact Dunbar Grammar School directly during the 2 day visit (Monday and Tuesday) if any information (including absence notification) needs to be passed on at this time.
- Medical information from the primary schools has been transferred to first aid staff at Dunbar Grammar School. Pupils with asthma should carry their own inhalers for the three days.
- If your child has an EpiPen, it will be at Dunbar Grammar School during the visit (Friday, Monday and Tuesday) and then returned to their primary school.
