



WE NEED YOUR HELP TO KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE!

- At Dunbar Primary School – John Muir Campus has only **7** disabled parking spaces
- Currently there are at least **5 Children** from P1- P3 that are blue badge holders, their conditions range from Cerebral Palsy, a very visible disability where a wheelchair/various equipment is needed, to Learning Disability and/or Autism, both are non-visible disabilities where the child has poor or no safety awareness. These children can feel anxious or upset making it necessary for a support teacher to meet parents at their car to help take the child into school. There are also other parents/grandparents/carers/siblings who have their own blue badge and need one of the limited spaces.



- If you park/drop off/turn around/wait in a parked car or even enter this car park, you are creating **congestion** and **reducing visibility** for children with additional support needs, and their parents/carers. Over the last few weeks this is becoming increasingly dangerous, sometimes even restricting these children from accessing their cars.
- On many occasions, these children have not been able to get a space, putting them at risk of injury or illness.

- There are **NO EXCUSES** for using this disabled car park if you do not have a blue badge. Please make use of the many spaces on the street, at Bleachingfield, the Masonic Lodge or the Factory shop, all of which are in close walking distance.
- **PLEASE NOTE**: the dropped curb area within the disabled car park provides the **ONLY EMERGENCY ACCESS** to the schools main gates. It needs to be kept clear **at all times** for ambulance/fire access. Please do not use this area for turning/parking or dropping off at any time.
