

Community Hubs

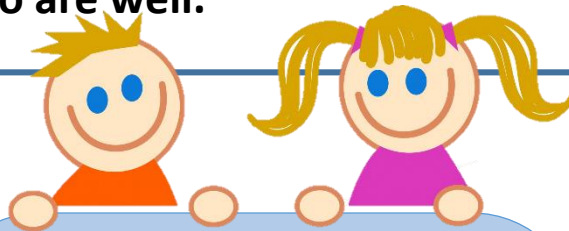
Providing emergency childcare for identified families during school closures.

Your child will be offered a space if you are a keyworker with no responsible adult at home to support childcare **OR** the school have identified ongoing support is required to support your child through the closures.

At the Community Hubs children will be provided with:

- Space to play and learn
- Support from teaching staff to participate in learning provided by your child's school.
- Opportunities to be active outdoors

All hubs will operate within the Government guidelines of social distancing and handwashing. Attendance can only for those who are well.

All Community Hubs will be open 9am to 3pm with teaching staff to support learning activities

If there is enough demand, a breakfast club from 7am-9am and after school care from 3pm-7pm can be provided.
