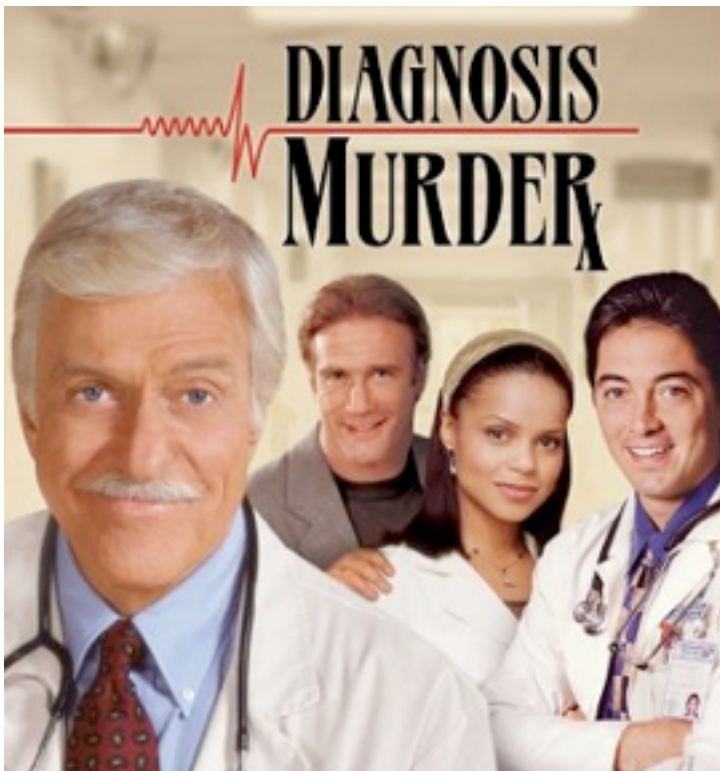


Diagnosis Murder - Today until the end of your Life
