The Competition

There will be three rounds.

1st Round – 16 and Under

- Six cupcakes with 3 flavours which taste and/or look to evoke the theme of Summer.
- These cupcakes will be produced at home and brought in on the day.
- A sign must be produced which indicates the flavours and ingredients.

2nd Round – Over 16

- 2 cakes (stacked or side by side etc) with two flavours decorated to show North Berwick, to fit on a 12 inch board
- This will be produced at home and brought in on the day.
- A sign must be produced which indicates the flavours and ingredients.

3rd Round - Everyone

- Each contestant will be provided with a 6-inch dummy cake.
- Each contestant will be allowed to bring in 6 pieces of equipment which **must** include a rolling pin and knife or smoother.
- The contestant will have 45 minutes to decorate the cake to the theme of children.

5. If you use gold, silver, or other metallic colour/dust/leaf, please make sure that the product is EDIBLE (non-toxic does NOT mean edible). Please display the bottle/container next to your work.
6. Please respect the decision of the judges.
7. Whilst reasonable care will be taken of your cakes, Playgroup cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
8. Please don't remove your cakes from the Competition Hall until after the close of the competition.
9. Competitions are open to everyone but they must indicate whether they are competing in the 16 and Under category or the Over 16 category.
