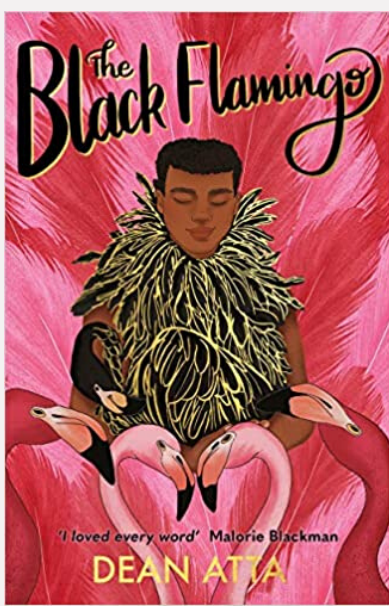

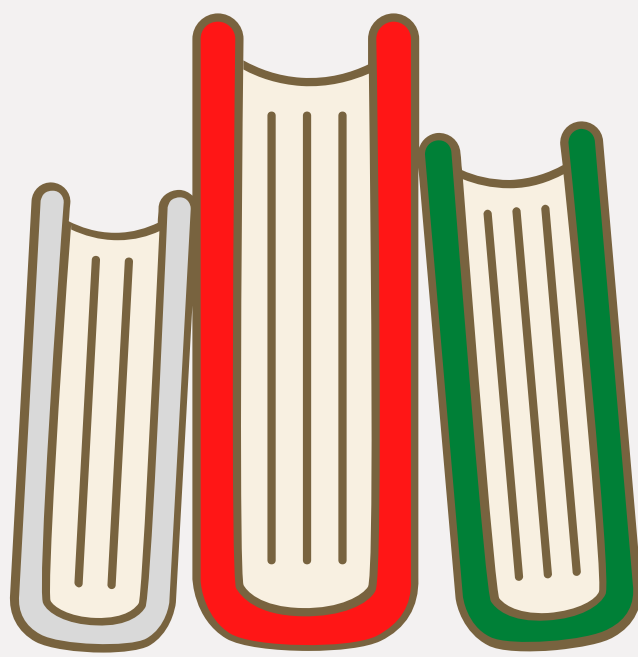

Although the National Library of Scotland (NLS) building is shut, their extensive collections, online resources and activities are still available. This includes the Moving Image Archive, Map Images and the Learning Zone for BGE resources and teaching ideas.

As a resident of Scotland, you can register for free access to the online journals and databases that the NLS offer: these include full-text scholarly and peer-reviewed publications, as well as some academic ebooks. Just as an example, if you sign up for access journal articles can be downloaded as PDFs which can then be shared with Senior pupils for analysis and critical discussion.

Pupils can also be encouraged to register for access, although this may be more appropriate next session when they start research for coursework essays or dissertations.

Each article is taken from relevant and reliable sources, and, when an article is accessed online, it contains additional vetted web-links for further research.

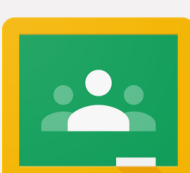
Issues Online is available to all NBHS pupils and staff to use from home. All content is copyright approved, so can be copied and distributed with no concerns.
