


The below URL and log-in details can be shared with pupils. The online resources, the majority of which are magazines, are available for use with no charge or obligation until September 2020. Titles include:

WWW.PRESSREADER.COM

PressReader provides full content digital replicas of more than 7000 titles from 100 countries in 60 languages, and allows users to view magazines and newspapers on-screen exactly as they would appear in a print edition. Publications include: The Guardian, The independent, The Scotsman, L'Express, Datum and many more.

Advanced features include keyword searching, language translation, text-to-voice, article sharing and printing/saving as PDF. Content is kept up-to-date and is often available before the print edition.

How do I access PressReader?

(You must be a member of ELC libraries - if you are not please contact me for help to register online. All pupils are already members.)

Access is through the URL above or download the free app to your device.

Click Sign in and choose the Library or Group option. Search for your library, East Lothian, then click enter.

You will then need to enter your Library membership number:

- if you have a 16 digit smartcard number, enter the first 14 digits only
- if you have a library card, enter the B and the following 9 digits

You can then create a personalised account if you wish, if not, skip this stage. You now have 30 days free access, which can be easily renewed by signing out then back in again at the end of the 30 days.
