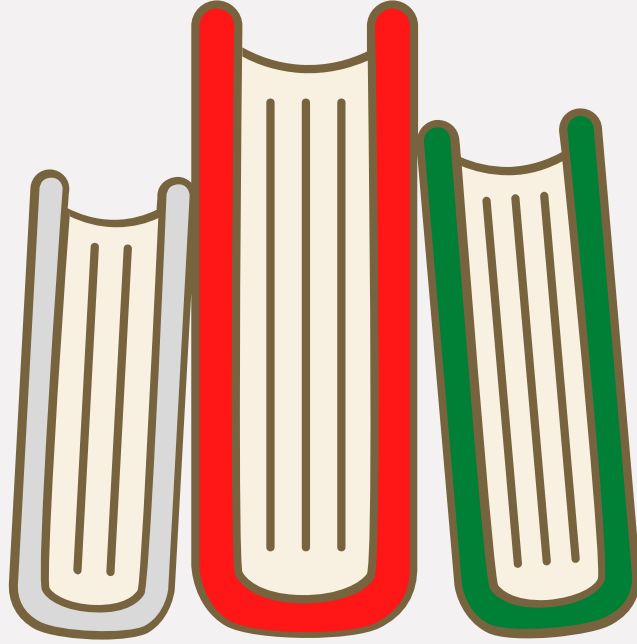

IQ-Files is an online encyclopaedia aimed at pupils aged 9-13, with content written specifically for their level and ability. Subjects covered include Science, History, Geography, Art, Literature and more. Each topic page has multiple downloadable pictures and diagrams which can be incorporated by pupils or yourself into work or reports. Plus each encyclopaedia entry has text-to-voice function at the top of the page which enables greater equity of access.

SCRAN is an online learning resource database with over 360,000 images and multimedia files available to search, download and use (with attribution) from museums, galleries, archives and the media.

To access this database, use the above link - you will need an East Lothian library membership card. This link can be distributed to all pupils as well, as they are all members of East Lothian libraries.

- Click the link above.
- Choose East Lothian Council from the drop-down menu.
- Enter your library membership number
 - If you have a 16-digit smartcard number, enter the first 14 digits only
 - If you have a membership number beginning with B, enter the B and the following 9 digits.
 - If you have an online membership number beginning with H, enter the H and the following 7 digits.
