18 May – onwards

History

Pupils will begin a study of Scotland's history by examining the people who first lived here. They will travel through time starting with the Iron Age, examining written evidence and online resources. The first challenge will be to build their own Iron Age crannog/broch or create a factfile on one of their choosing. Next, there will be an opportunity for investigation into the influence and legacy of the Romans on Scotland.

Computing & Business

In S2 Business & Computing pupils learn about Administration & IT, Business and Computing. We will be starting with Administration & IT focusing on areas such as health and safety in the workplace and using technology.

Pupils will be completing their Rotation 3 assessment during the week beginning 25th May, everyone will have had revision materials posted to their classroom to help. Everyone will then be moving into S2 science and Rotation 4, 'An Expedition', the following week. Topics to be covered include biodiversity, rocks and friction.

CDT

Pupils are working on 'A FEW MINUTES OF DESIGN' a set of simple exercises to spark creativity (4 lessons)

1. Organising Rules - coming up with a method for organising objects.
2. Ingenuity pitch - what was the designer trying to achieve?
3. One object 100 ways - as many uses you can think of for a given object.
4. Odd One Out - which object is the odd one out and why do you think this?

Music

26 musical challenges

Pupils are asked to choose one or two each week and turn it in on Google classroom.

Pupils should keep playing instruments as much as they can, and use tutorials on Youtube to inspire you.

Maths

S2 pupils will be starting on reading and interpreting information from graphs. We've been bombarded with graphs about the spread of Covid-19, so thinking carefully about this topic will help pupils understand the information in those graphs.

Mr Cox's class and some of Miss O'Brien's are working around 2nd level with some support to access 3rd level. This week we will look at arithmetic involving powers and roots, and every day we will do a little mental-maths practice to keep our strategies tuned up.

Mr Lawson's class will begin S2 with a revision of multiplying and dividing by powers of 10, and move onto calculations involving multiples of 10, 100 and 1000. Pupils will have 3 lessons with a variety of work including worksheets and online games. Weekly quizzes will be set to test the understanding of recently covered topics.

English

Mrs Conway – pupils are preparing solo talks

Mrs Gorka - pupils are working on the creative writing 'The Superhero' project.

Mrs Nathan – pupils are working on personal writing.

Mrs. Gibson – pupils are working on creative writing skills

Miss Rudman – pupils are working on their Endangered Animal reports

Mrs Hudson – Pupils are writing a one page introduction to their new teacher, including a photo.

Mr Maxwell – Pupils are finishing their auto-biographies. And finishing reading Boy by Roald Dahl. If this is complete they should try some of the Close Reading exercises which have been posted. Keep up your personal reading.

HE

Pupils will begin looking at storage of ingredients, choice of ingredients, seasonal and local produce and characteristics of ingredients. There will also be an option for a weekly baking/ cooking task.

Pupils also have the option of completing a weekly bake.

Art & Design

Pupils will be building on skills they have been developing from first year. They will begin working on a poster design unit which will refine and develop their knowledge of the visual elements. They will also be working on some written work where they will be learning about artists and art movements.

PE

Pupils are reviewing the Sports Hero project with a focus on training methods used and how personal skills impact on performance: determination, concentration, motivation, goal setting.

Geography

Pupils will begin S2 Geography continuing with their unit on Coasts. They will investigate some features found in a coastal environment and look at how humans manage eroding coastlines. They will finish the term by challenging their perception about the world by thinking about the world as a "Global Village".

Drama

Pupils should be completing the 'Capture a Moment in Time' Time Capsule worksheet.

RME

S2 RME pupils will be studying Judaism. They will investigate the main beliefs, practices and festivals of the religion.

French

Pupils are learning about school life, opinions of subjects, teachers and talking about the building and after school clubs. In due course pupils will watch a French film to compare Scottish education with the French system.

Modern Studies

This year, pupils will study 2 topics; Topic 1. The Role & Influence of the Media and Topic 2. Global Terrorism

Throughout both topics, pupils will gain a knowledge and understanding of the types, role and influence of the media in the UK and of the causes and responses to global terrorism. Pupils will learn how to structure Knowledge answers using the Point, Explain, Example structure. Pupils will also be developing their source skills further from S1, by learning how to interpret sources of information and how to structure source answers. Learning will be through a range of resources, including a pupil booklet, Google slides, documentaries, as well as online discussion and debate using real life examples.
