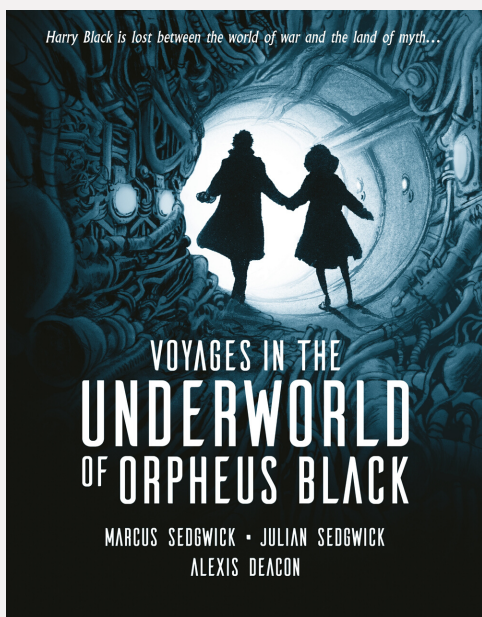

My last pick from the Carnegie medal shortlist! This is a fascinating combination of novel, poetry, illustration and "found objects" which come together to create an enchanting tale of two brothers - one a soldier, the other a conscientious objector - while reworking the Greek myth of Orpheus and Eurydice. Marcus Sedgwick is a veteran of the Carnegie medal shortlists, and this book is a gem. I'm on my second reading - it is worth it to fully absorb the full story. The illustrations are haunting and are the cherry on top of this tale.

### ONLINE RESOURCE OF THE WEEK

ClickView is an online video content resource, with collections of videos for primary and secondary schools, across multiple subjects and topics. ClickView have made videos and additional resources free to access to staff, parents and pupils.

The primary and secondary libraries are subdivided into Early, First, Second, BGE, National 5 and Higher. These are then divided further by subject and then within each subject by topic. Videos can be shared, either through emailing a link or embedding the video directly from ClickView into a chosen Google Classroom.

Music of the World;

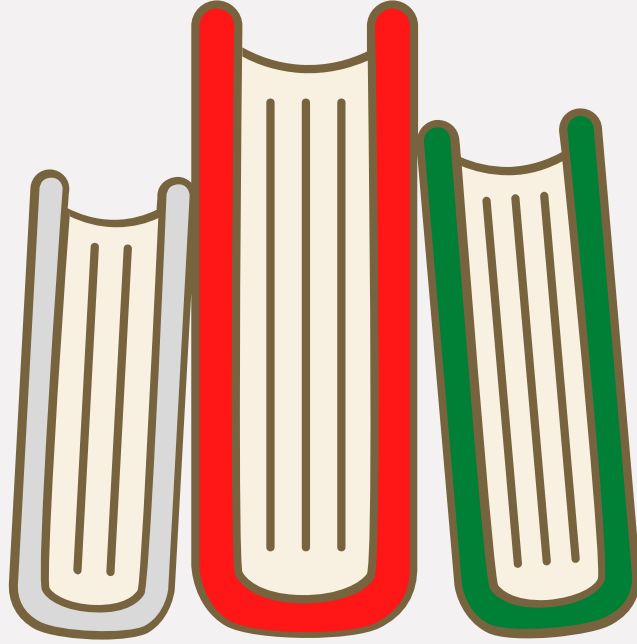
Shakespeare;

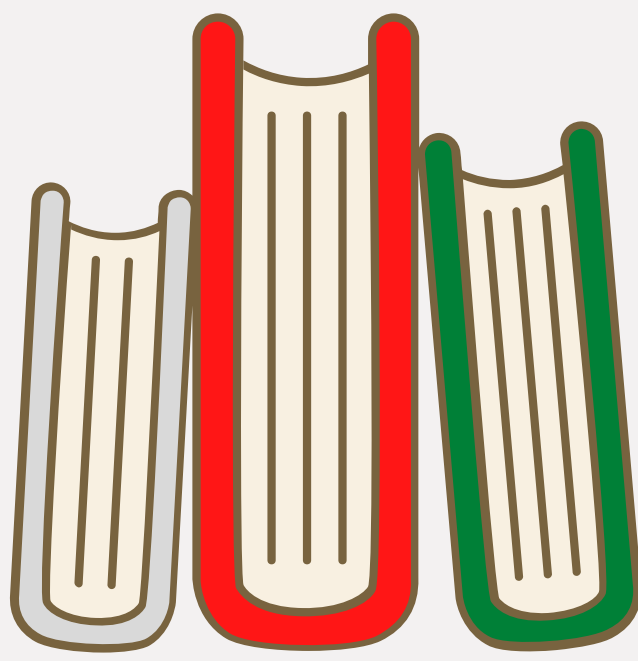
BorrowBox Library app for Apple/Android/Kindle Fire

BorrowBox is a free ebooks and audiobooks platform provided by East Lothian's library service. You can download up to 10 items for three weeks, place requests and access Children's, Young Adult and Adult titles. A fantastic chance to read or listen to what is most popular among our young people at the moment, use with your own kids or for yourself to unwind!

After downloading the app, in order to register you will need your Library Membership Number and an email address.

- Enter your Library Membership Number where it asks for a username
- If you have a Membership Number beginning with B, include the B and the 9 digits.
- If you have a 16-digit smartcard number, enter the first 14 digits only
- If you have an online Membership number beginning with H, enter the H and 7 digits.
- Your PIN/Password is the last four digits of your Library Membership Number (the password for the username 12345678912345 is 2345 - this is the last four digits of the 14 numbers)
