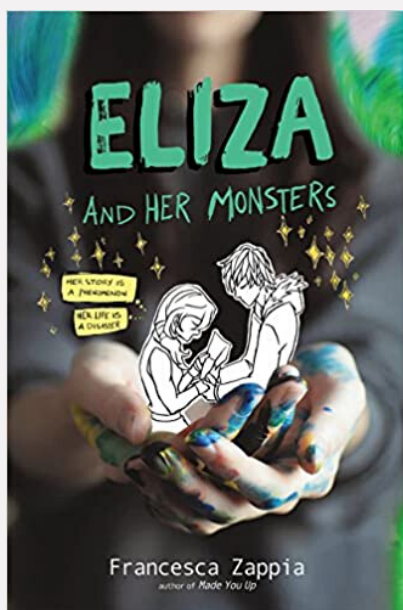

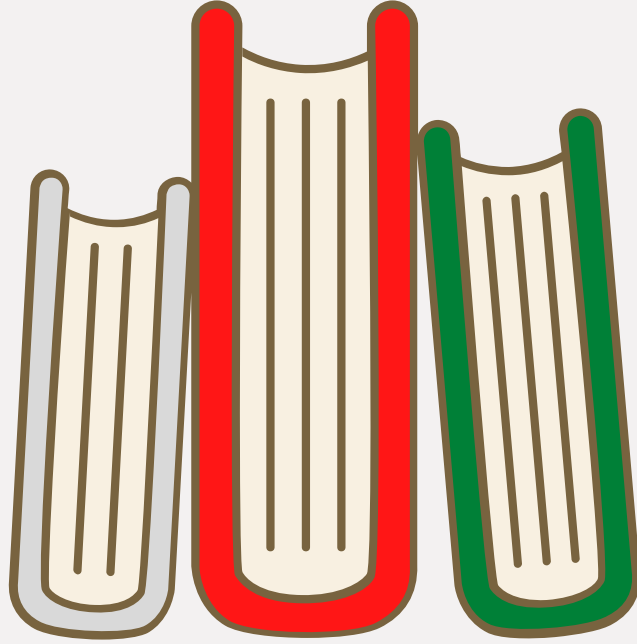

Audiopi is an online downloadable podcast service, which has provided free access to all its podcasts across subjects and topics until the 1st October 2020. Log in details above.

Audiopi has approx. 2000 different podcasts on a variety of topics across English, History, Biology, Physics, R.E., Sociology and Psychology. I have asked for access to those podcasts which are of most similarity to the topics studied in CfE, but if you do look at the list and would like anything added, do let me know.

The log in details can be shared with pupils, podcasts assigned to them and then discussed after - it may make a nice change to listen instead of stare at a screen!

How to Access Universal Class

Enter your Library Membership Number

- If you have a Membership Number beginning with B, enter the B and the 9 numbers
- If you have a 16-digit Smartcard Number, enter the first 14 digits only (with no spaces)
- If you have an online Membership number beginning with H, enter the H and the 7 numbers
