

Skipper Crochet Pattern

The end height of Skipper depends on the combination of hook and yarn.

4.5mm hook with 6mm yarn gave a height of around 15" – see picture

3.5mm hook with 4mm yarn gave a height of around 12"

Legs

6 dc into a magic circle (6 sts).

2 dc into each st from the previous round (12 sts).

1 dc into the first 2 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (16 sts).

1 dc into the each st for 23 rounds and fasten off yarn.

Make 2.

Arms

6 dc into a magic circle (6 sts).

2 dc into each st from the previous round (12 sts).

1 dc into the each st for 21 rounds and fasten off yarn

Make 2.

Body & Head

6 dc into a magic circle (6 sts).

2 dc into each st from the previous round (12 sts).

2 dc into each st from the previous round (24 sts).

1 dc into the first 8 sts, 2 dc into the next 4 sts. Repeat twice. (32 sts).

1 dc into the first 10 sts, 2 dc into the next 4 sts. 1 dc into the next 12 sts. 2 dc into the next 4 sts, 1 dc into the last 2 sts. (40 sts)

1 dc into each stitch for 5 rounds.

1 dc into the first 14 sts, dc2tog, 1 dc into the next 18 sts, sc2tog, 1 dc into last 4 sts. (38 sts)

1 dc into the first 14 sts, dc2tog, 1 dc into the next 17 sts, sc2tog, 1 dc into last 3 sts. (36 sts)

1 dc into the first 14 sts, dc2tog, 1 dc into the next 16 sts, sc2tog, 1 dc into last 2 sts. (34 sts)

1 dc into the first 14 sts, dc2tog, 1 dc into the next 15 sts, sc2tog, 1 dc into last 1 sts. (32 sts)

1 dc into each stitch for 8 rounds.

Join Arms

Stuff the arms to be as firm as required.

Join the arms by picking up a stitch from the top and bottom of the arms and combine into a dc st.

Arms will be joined over 6 sts. Complete 1 round joining arms in keeping with the body shape.

Roughly, 1 dc into first 10 sts, join arm over next 6 sts, 1 dc into next 10 sts, join arm over last 6 sts. (32 sts).

Stuff the body to be as firm as required.



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Make neck and head

Stuffing can be added as the head is made. Stuff the neck firmly so Skipper can keep his head up.

Dc2tog 16 times. (16 sts).

1 dc into each stitch for 3 rounds.

1 dc into the first 3 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (20 sts).

1 dc into the first 4 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (24 sts).

1 dc into the first 5 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (28 sts).

1 dc into the first 6 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (32 sts).

1 dc into the first 7 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (36 sts).

1 dc into the first 8 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (40 sts).

1 dc into the first 9 sts, 2 dc into the next st. Repeat 4 times (44 sts).

1 dc into each stitch for 2 rounds.

1 dc into the first 9 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (40 sts).

1 dc into the first 8 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (36 sts).

1 dc into the first 7 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (32 sts).

1 dc into the first 6 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (28 sts).

1 dc into the first 5 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (24 sts).

1 dc into the first 4 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (20 sts).

1 dc into the first 3 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (16 sts).

1 dc into the first 2 sts, dc2tog. Repeat 4 times. (12 sts).

Dc3tog until closed.

Attach Legs

Stuff and sew on the legs.
