### **Arrangements for returning to school in August 2021**

We are looking forward to welcoming our children back into school on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> August.

**Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August** - In-service Day (closed to children)

**Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> August** - In-service Day (closed to children)

**Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> August** – All children return to school / nursery. **P1 first day at school** - see separate letter.

**Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> August onwards** – All children in school / nursery.

Children are welcome to arrive at school between **8.55–9.05am** through their allocated door for a soft start. Children in P2-P7 do not line up in the mornings, but come straight into school. P1 children will line up in their classes at 8:55am (see separate letter). We have included pictures of the allocated doors below. **Please note the change to our arrival times.**

## **Other Information**

Our school colours are red, grey, white and black. Where possible, all children should come to school in school uniform. Branded sweatshirts should not be worn in school. A selection of preloved and new uniforms are in our front entrance – please help yourself, or contact us if we can support in any way. ### **Clothing Grants and Free School Meals**

If you would like a sweatshirt/poloshirt with our Pinkie logo, these uniforms can be ordered through this website: <https://garmentprinter.co.uk/> and can be collected on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August** outside the school entrance from 1.30-3.30.

**PE Kits:** On PE days children should come to school wearing: a PE kit (shorts/joggers/leggings and a t-shirt). We will send details of your child's PE slots in the new term.

**Other items to bring to school:** Your child should bring; a named water bottle, indoor shoes (to be kept in school) and outdoor coats/jackets and wellies as required. Please ensure all items are clearly named.

**Snacks:** P1 & P2 children will receive free fruit for snack on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. On a Monday and Friday children should bring their own choice of healthy snack. All children in P3-P7 should bring a healthy snack to school each day. Please avoid snacks containing nuts.

**School Meals:** Please remember to use your ipay account to pre-order school lunches.

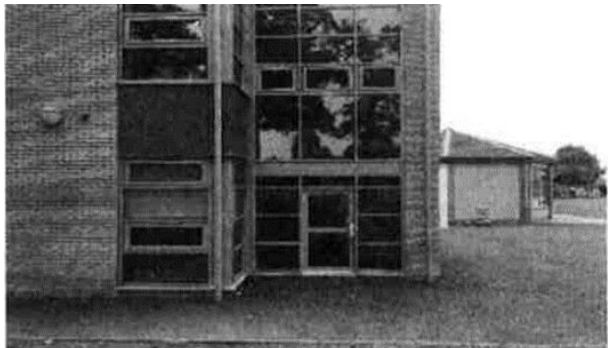
- School lunches will continue be served in classrooms from Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September.

**Doors:** Children will enter and exit school by the same door (see pictures below).

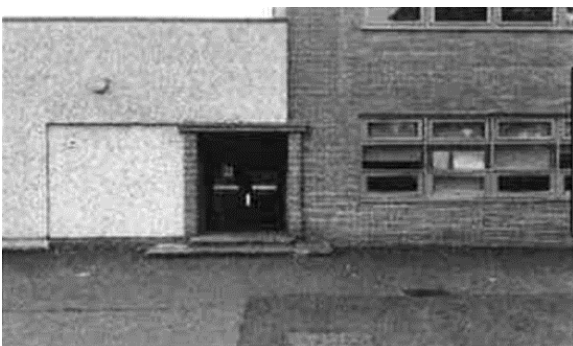
