Important Information

Our Pinkie school colours are red, white, grey and black. Pupils should wear school uniform every day to school.

On **PE days** children should come to school in appropriate jogging bottoms or leggings but should wear a **plain polo shirt and school sweatshirt**.

Please ensure children have a pair of named indoor shoes. These can remain in school.

We do lots of outdoor learning – please come to school with a jacket.

P1 and P2 are provided with free fruit at snack time. All other children should bring a healthy snack to school, and everyone should have a named water bottle.

Phones and phone watches are kept in a safe place in classrooms. Children are **not** permitted to keep phones or wear phone watches and these must be handed to class teachers in the morning.
