2. **How successfully did the Liberal Reforms, of 1906–1914, deal with the problem of poverty in Britain in the early 1900s?**
3. **How important were concerns about the extent of poverty in Britain in the Liberal Government's decision to introduce social reforms between 1906 and 1914?**
4. **"Their contribution during World War 1 was the main reason why the majority of women gained the vote in 1918." How valid is this view?**
5. **How successfully did the Labour government of 1945-1951 deal with the social problems identified in the Beveridge Report of 1942?**
6. **How important was the role of pressure groups in Britain becoming more democratic between 1851 and 1928?**
