The award-winning Fletcher's Cottage spa has announced a brand-new spa therapist apprenticeship programme in a bid to help boost recruitment within the industry. Archerfield has partnered with Glasgow-based 'The Academy' to provide private apprenticeships, training and recognised qualifications with a guaranteed job available at the end of the course.

Those looking to kickstart their career in the spa industry, or simply to learn a new trade as a second career, can sign up for the four-month apprenticeship programme with no qualifications required.

This scheme is the first private apprenticeship through CIBTAC, (Confederation of International Beauty Therapy and Cosmetology), an internationally recognised qualification.

The apprenticeship programme – which expects to initially welcome two trainees, offers the Level Two Facial and Level Three Massage with a mix of practical training, remote theory learning, on- site learning at Fletcher's Cottage Spa and CIBTAC exam once training is complete.

Those who successfully complete the course and pass the final exam will join Fletcher's Cottage Spa at Archerfield as a permanent employee.

The first round of course intakes begins on the 14th August 2023.
