What's happening in Nursery -

Changing Weather -

Appropriate footwear -

There are lots of outdoor activities that the children enjoy which include climbing, skipping and running, please can you provide appropriate footwear such as trainers. We have found that children can scrape their toes if wearing sandals or flip-flops.

Graduation -

Our lovely pre-school children have been learning new songs to sing at their graduation which will take place on the 11 August at 2pm in the gym hall. We will be sending out invitations with tickets (2 adults only as space is limited) very soon. All our children are going to graduate together so our Monday/Tuesday group and our Wednesday/Thursday group will join up for this amazing celebration as they prepare for moving on to P1.

After auditing our nursery pick up times, we have decided to introduce a new routine. The children will all be sitting participating in a group activity when you come to collect them at 3pm. We will now have staff on the door and a designated member of staff who will collect your child from the group and bring them to you.
