Professor Florian is an internationally-acclaimed researcher and teacher/educator with a great wealth of expertise about developing inclusive educational practice. She has extensive international experience in special needs education and has worked on issues of disability classification, teacher education and inclusive education with a number of international agencies including UNICEF and the OECD.

What/who is the Inclusive, Reflective Practitioner?

Developing an approach to teaching and learning where there is a shift in practice from providing what works for most learners; along with something 'different' or 'additional' for those who experience difficulties, to accommodating all individual differences by extending what is generally available.
