Saturday 24th August, 12.30-3.30pm, Prestongrange Museum

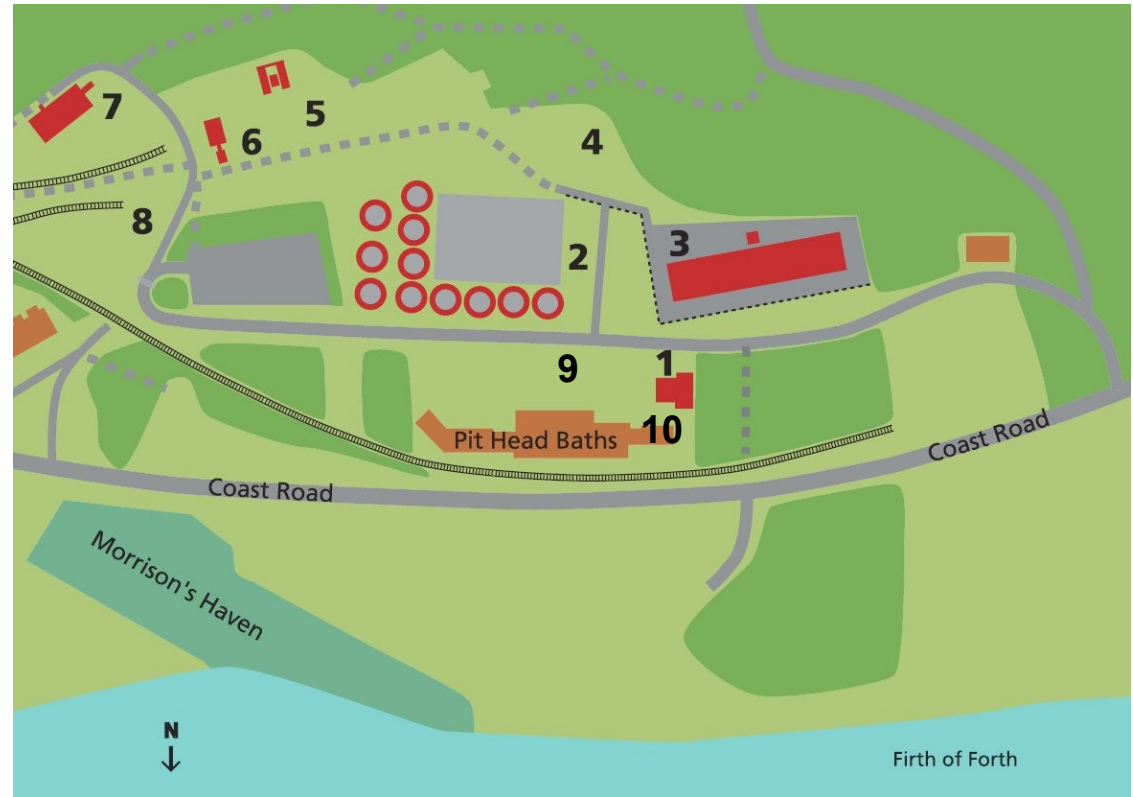

Kayaking

There will be 2 sessions for kayaking: 1pm – 2.15pm and 2.15pm – 3.30pm

There will be 8 children per session. Children must be primary 6 upwards.

Cost: £4 per child

Bookings for each session open on Friday 23rd August by visiting Prestongrange Museum, or phoning the museum on 0131 6532904. At least 30 minutes before the session begins, families must meet at the Visitor Centre in order to complete the appropriate paperwork. Families will then need to make their way over to the lagoons.

Any spaces remaining on either session will be advertised on the day outside the Visitor Centre.
