Can you find out the number on your door and your own address?</p>	<p>Let's try and make our very own little pigs or little pig houses. Can you draw different shapes and make your own pig/ house?</p> <p>We have provided a shape mat. Can you recognise and identify these on your own. Try drawing these independently.</p> <p>Can you make a house using anything else in your house? (lego/ duplo/ junk modelling)</p>	<p>Can you go on a local walk around the village, try to find and collect stones, straw/grass and sticks. What do they feel like? Can build our own Little pig houses.</p> <p>Let's see if we can collect 3-5 stones / sticks / piles of grass. Can you blow them over like the big bad wolf?</p> <p>Before you go on a walk can you independently put on your own coat, shoes, scarves, gloves and when you return home can you take these off by yourself?</p>
